Arrived Piraeus 12 th April (1941)  
Landed Piraeus 13 April  
Went to Ekali.  
Personnel evacuated 23 April  
Most officers and Nurses  
24 th Col Kay was ordered out  
The Registrar Kingsley  
and two orderlies were  
ordered out

Started moving from  
Ekali on 7 May  
Captain Barlin in charge.  
of advance party to Kokinnia  
Ekali was completely  
evacuated by the 9th.  
Capt. McNamara & 8 OR's  
left to look after seriously  
wounded patients.
