

**Reprint of hand written notes re the following:**

**Madam Zanna**

Early May in Kokinnia rep of Greek Red Cross with Milk, Eggs and Raisins. & Sultanias -- in hundred weights.

German – about 5/- a day in German Reich marks.  
(Camp moving in Germany)

Canteen:

Three Bibles – medical supplies – local lady at Kaphissia – well known.

Small stout lady with unbounded energy -- things they needed themselves – asked British Red Cross to replace later.

Mrs Rollo – Alexandria – organized a ball for Greek Red Cross – (Christmas 1943)  
Ball -- 80 Egyptian Pound.

Prince Phillip of Greece was present - invitation Greek Community.

I was with the 2/5 Australian Hospital in Greece.

We are very grateful of your help in Greece and to Mrs Kay when she visited your country.

I want now to ask you,

I am writing the records of the 2/5 Hospital into a history & I wanted any information you may be able to tell me.

First – do you recall Nestor.C.Constantoulis, who was a doctor and may have been attached as a Greek Army medical officer to the Unit.?
